HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS

“Though our righteousness is secure in Jesus, there will come a day when we stand before Jesus and account for how we have lived. On that day, Jesus will question us about how we treated the poor, the marginalized, the powerless, and the vulnerable. This is an overwhelming truth. You are probably asking, “How do I help? What should I do? Now that I know this injustice exists—where do I go from here?” Taking a step may seem overwhelming, but all we need to do is take one step. We can take heart in Jesus’ words, who told us that the kingdom of God is made up of small steps of faith and showed us that even helping one person in need of justice makes an eternal difference.”
