REIMAGINE THE WALL
Nehemiah 4:1-6

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE(S)

2 Corinthians 4:8-9

HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS

Chapter 4 of Nehemiah records a relentless assault against Nehemiah and Israel for endeavoring to build a wall around Jerusalem. Under Zerubbabel a wave of Jews had returned to Jerusalem from exile. These formerly enslaved people had rebuilt the temple but fail to rebuild the wall around the city. As Nehemiah returned to Jerusalem to rebuild the wall, he was met with much resistance.

1. Why do you think that Sanballat and Tobiah ridiculed the work that was conducted under Nehemiah?

2. Why do you think there was disdain for rebuilding the wall around Jerusalem but not the temple?

3. When rebuilding a business, ministry or small group, do you think it is advantageous to see beyond the ruins? Explain your answer.

4. What can we learn from Nehemiah about addressing the wall wreckers of life?

5. Nehemiah reimagined the walls of his beloved Jerusalem rebuilt. Explain how life is better reimagined.
