HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS

The 2nd letter to the Corinthians was written by the Apostle Paul to the church in Corinth, a city in Ancient Greece. The purpose of this letter was to address various issues and callings confronting the church such as division and false teaching. In 2 Corinthians 9:6-12, Paul is discussing the topic of generosity and giving. He encourages the Corinthians to give willingly, and cheerfully, emphasizing the importance of a generous heart.
