HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS

SG QUESTIONS

3. God commanded Hosea to marry a woman who would be unfaithful to him and would cause him many headaches. How do you handle situations where God tells you to do something that you are not comfortable with, or you do not understand?

4. How would you view a marriage like Hosea and Gomer's?

5. Share an experience where you have been distracted or preoccupied with other interests or worries, then were redirected by the love of God.
